ORDINANCE AMENDING GARBAGE RATES AND ESTABLISHING A RECYCLING FEE AND AN ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT TO THE GARBAGE AND RECYCLING SERVICE CHARGE FOR GARBAGE CUSTOMERS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF LIVERMORE, IOWA.

BE IT ORDAIN	ED, this day of, 200_, by the City Council of Livermore, Iow	⁄a,
that Chapter 106.	07 of the City Code of Livermore, Iowa, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:	
1. Schedule	e of Fees. The fees for solid waste collection and disposal service, used or available are:	:
A.	For each residential premises and for each dwelling unit of a multiple-family dwelling the charge is \$ 9.00 per month. This entitles customer to one bag per week with an additional charge of \$1.50 each for additional stickered bags.	
В.	For each bag, residents will pay \$.50 each. All garbage must be placed in a Livermore City garbage bag.	:
C.	For commercial, industrial, governmental and institutional premises the charge is \$9.00 per month or \$10.00 per dumpster plus a \$15.00 charge each time it is dumped.)
D.	For each residential, governmental and commercial premise, a recycling fee in the amount of \$1.50 per month shall be charged. This will be added to the garbage fee.	
E.	The monthly rate for garbage and recycling shall be adjusted annually as follows:	
	On or before the 1 st day of July each year, the City Clerk shall increase the garbage and recycling rate by 1% per annum.	
F.	Burn barrels will be emptied at a cost of \$15.00 each.	
G.	All rates and fees mentioned above may be set and amended from time to time by resolution of the council.	
	Payment of Bills. All fees are due and payable under the same terms and conditions provided for payment of a combined service account as contained in Section 92.03 of this Code of Ordinances. Solid waste collection service may be discontinued in accordance with the provisions contained in Section 92.04 if the combined service account becomes delinquent, and the provisions contained in Section 92.07 related to lie notices shall also apply in the event of a delinquent account.	en
